Garrett Augustus Morgan

Garrett Augustus Morgan was an inventor who lived a long time ago (from 1877 to 1963) in America.

At the time, roads were very busy. The first cars had recently been invented.

The new cars shared the roads with horses, carriages, bicycles and people. But there weren't any traffic lights so there were lots of accidents, especially at junctions.

Garrett saw a bad accident between a horse-drawn carriage and a car. He wanted to help solve the problem. So he invented the traffic light signal.

This invention made the streets safer for all and it's still used today.
