

NEW LEARNING: How to imitate and write a text.

1, Can you name 5 proper nouns – write them in your best handwriting.

2, Today you will be planning sentences about our story before writing them.

Mr Gumpy was written by **John Burningham**.



What should you remember?

1, Think of what you want to write about...

Mr Welsh: Mr Gumpy is a happy old man.

2, Say the sentence out loud...

Mr Welsh: Mr Gumpy is a happy old man.

3, Plan each word on your fingers (just like phonics)

1, Mr 2, Gumpy 3, is 4, a 5, happy
6, old 7 man.

4, Write the sentence

5, Check you have capital letters, finger spaces and full stops

6, Celebrate your work!

3, Can you think of and say your sentence out loud now – say it to a person in your house. Show them your capital letter and full stop like we do in class.

4, Now write it down.

Check your work! Have you got capital letters? Have you used finger spaces? Have you got a full stop?

Is this sentence correct?

Mr gumpy isa big apple.

I made 3 mistakes – can you find them?

Today you will be writing 6 sentences using your planning fingers. Can you write sentences about Mr Gumpy or the animals?
