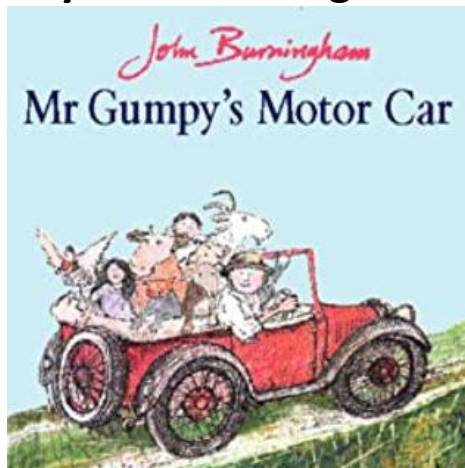

NEW LEARNING: How to imitate and write a text.

1, Can you write a great sentence about Mr Gumpy's car?

2, Today you will be drawing a story map of the whole story.

What should you remember?

1, Listen to the story again.

2, Stop the story after each page – what did I read?

Mr Welsh: How could you draw this?

3, Plan if you will need 1 picture or more to show what happens in the story.

4, Draw your story map – use lots of colour if you like.

5, Check that the story map is correct by watching the video again – is it in the right order?

6, Celebrate your work!

3, Can you add any words into the map that will help you to remember it?

4, Now retell the story in your own words. Can you put it on a video?

Today you will be drawing the story map of the story.

Make sure that it is in the right order – keep looking at the video and use your imagination. Can you send a picture of your story map please.
